Dear Wetaskiwin Regional Airport Neighbours:

The 2016 Wetaskiwin Evening Air Show is ready for take off on July 20th and it is anticipated to be another great spectator event.

This is the 6th occasion Wetaskiwin will hold an airshow and once again we want to ensure the safety and security of the Airport area residents and businesses. We anticipate that spectators will drive to various vantage points, with the mistaken assumptions that they can view the show from that location. This has the potential to create a security problem for the event or become a nuisance for you. Therefore, the City of Wetaskiwin will be enforcing the following road closures:

****Soft Close** – only vehicles with access identification bands will be allowed through. Discretion will be used for visitors, or patrons of businesses.

*****Hard Close** – **NO** vehicles will be allowed in or out. Area must be secured while the show is taking place. All times are approximate and subject to change.

To address your concerns or answer any questions we have scheduled the following public meeting. If you require more vehicle identification bands, you will be able to pick them up at this time.

Be assured, you will have complete access to your property during the soft closure times as long as you use the coloured vehicle access identification bands provided. Please place this band around your rear view mirror so that it is easily identified by the volunteers at the barricades. Remember, no access is allowed during the hard closure times.

It is not our intent to restrict access to your home or business. You are welcome to enjoy the limited viewing of the Air Show from your property. However, we encourage you to enjoy the full staged view of the performance and experience the special displays, presentations, sounds, music and commentary only available at the show site.
